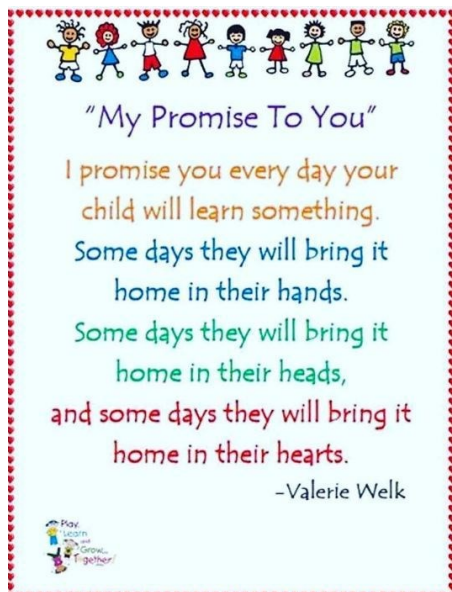

I have a passion for supporting children in their learning through play. I enjoy learning new things and being adventurous.

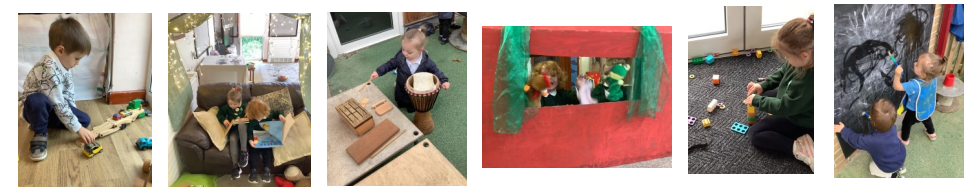

A Typical Nursery Day

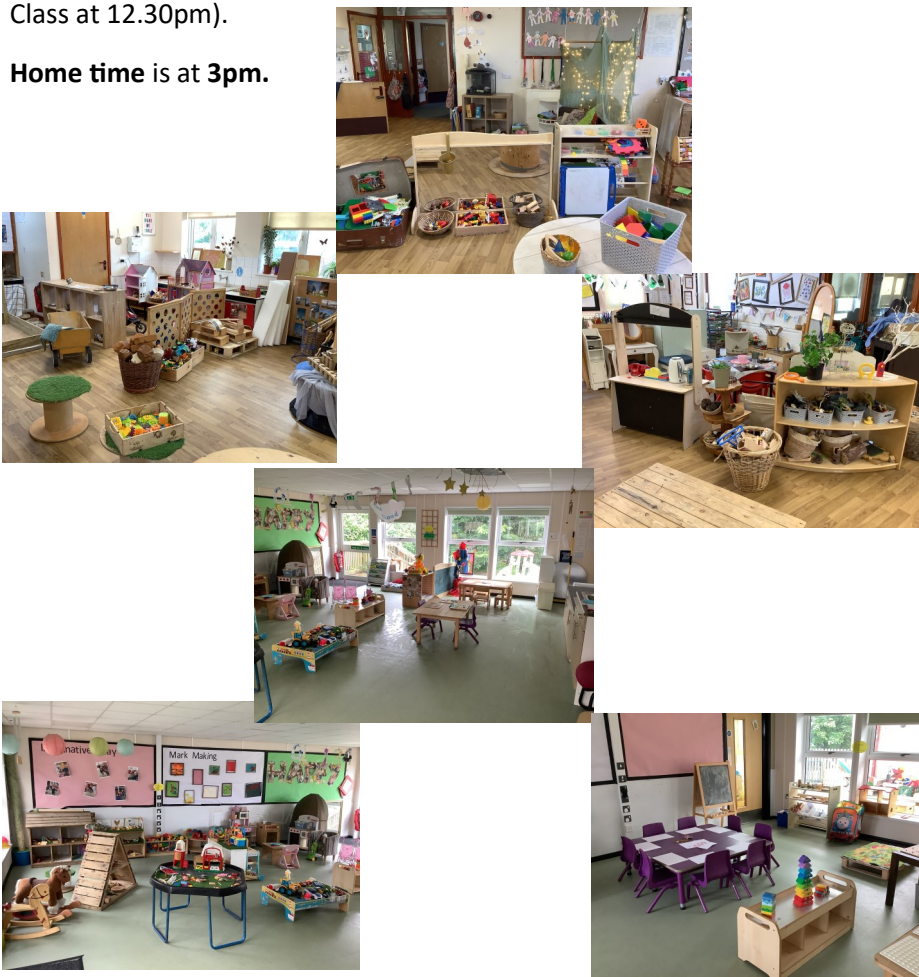
Nursery doors open at **8:50am**—please arrive on time to ensure that all children are settled and ready for their session to begin.

Snack time—Please ensure your child has a named water bottle and healthy snack. We always have a small selection of fruit available.

Home time for morning session is **11.50am**

Lunch time is at 12pm for those staying all day, joined by those children coming for the afternoon session. (Caterpillar Class eat at 12pm, Butterfly Class at 12.30pm).

Home time is at **3pm**.



What do you need to wear?

- *A West Croft /green school sweatshirt (available from the school office)
- *Comfortable clothes that you do not mind getting a bit dirty
- *Elasticated waists are best to encourage independence when visiting the toilet—joggers/leggings are ideal—please avoid jeans or anything with buttons
- *Comfortable sensible shoes, preferably with Velcro rather than laces. We change into wellington boots for the garden when its wet so children need to be able to easily change their shoes. No open toed shoes, flip flops, sandals, crocs, jelly shoes or heels please.



Please label everything including shoes and spare clothes!



What do you need to bring?

- A named water bottle
- A healthy snack for the morning session (no nuts please)
- A rucksack bag with a complete change of clothes including underwear (nappies and wipes if needed) - **NOT** a carrier bag
- Sun cream and a sun hat when it is warm
- A warm coat, hat and gloves when it is cold
- Wellington boots if possible (these can be left at Nursery)
- A healthy packed lunch if you are staying all day or coming in for an afternoon session. Please do not include large chocolate bars.

Please do not bring anything with nuts including peanut butter or cereal bars containing nuts.
